NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

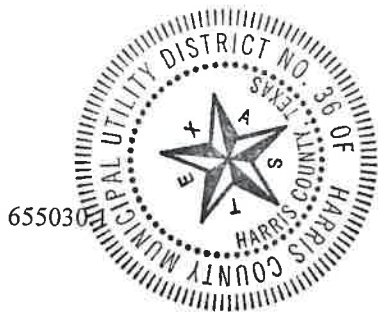
The meeting will be held on Thursday, January 12, 2023, at 12:00 Noon.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of minutes of the November 10, 2022, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Consider appointment of new Director to fill vacancy on the Board of Directors;
4. Review and approve audit for fiscal year ended September 30, 2022;
5. Authorize attorney to file audit for fiscal year ended September 30, 2022 with Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts within 210 days of the fiscal year end in compliance with § 140.008, Texas Local Government Code;
6. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including review of financial and investment reports, authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
8. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with the District;
9. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;

10. Report of and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collection attorney, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claims;
11. Grant exemptions from taxation for 2023, and the adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
12. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2023, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
13. Operations Report, including:
 - (a) Monthly Report;
 - (b) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
 - (c) Any appeals of District charges; and
 - (d) Authorization of the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
14. Authorize operator to provide required information to districts receiving water from the District relative to Consumer Confidence Reports;
15. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, for the construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans, including:
 - i. Water Distribution System Rehabilitation/Replacement;
 - (b) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders, including:
 - i. Wastewater Collection System Rehabilitation, Phase II (T. Gray Utility & Rehab);
 - (c) Acceptance of site and/or easement and/or utility conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - (d) Status of Storm Water Quality Permits;
 - (e) Requests for Utility Commitment Letters; and
 - (f) Discussion regarding City of Houston Groundwater Reduction Plan and outlook for District compliance with same;

16. Discussion of renewal of District insurance coverages and authorize solicitation of proposals for same;
17. Developer's Report;
18. Report on the District's generator, including status of receipt of revenues associated with performance during Winter Storm Uri;
19. Attorney's Report;
20. Convene in Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.074 and/or Section 551.071, Texas Government Code for consultation with District's attorney regarding personnel matters;
21. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Closed Session; and
22. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
